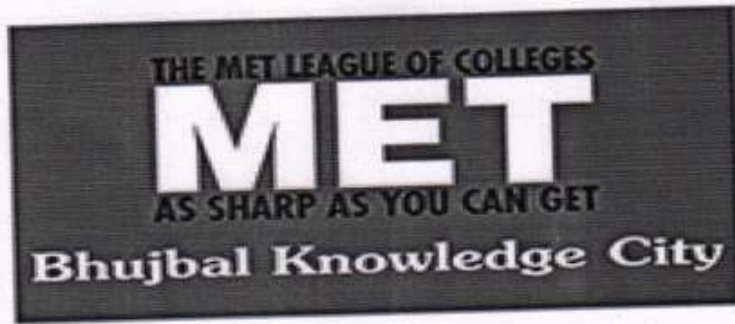

Intellectual Property Policy

1. Preamble

Institute of Engineering (IOE) established in 2006 at Bhujbal Knowledge City, Nashik under the umbrella of MET with world class infrastructure, centralized library, conference rooms, seminar halls, and amphitheater. IOE has fully dedicated and well qualified faculty with passion who consider teaching as mission rather than profession. The Institute of Engineering, Bhujbal Knowledge City, Nashik possesses the necessary know-how to develop future professionals, sharpen their abilities so as to make realization of their potential. To achieve these, we strongly believe in excellence and exquisiteness, which can be achieved with competent faculty, innovating pedagogy, backed by strong practical input. Moreover, regular national conferences / seminars / workshops, personality development programmes, language skills, management activities, industry interaction and orientation towards research, distinguish us from rest. Our student-centered teaching is aimed at participatory education and personality development.

MET's Institute of Engineering, Bhujbal Knowledge City, Nashik have a fundamental role in socio-economic development. Innovation and scientific development are the basis for economic, technological and social mobility as well as for economic growth. Research institute is a main superstructure in which scientific development and innovation takes place and the intellectual property (IP) system is the main mechanism that enables institute and society at large to capture the value of innovation. Institute serves as the starting point for a common understanding about IP, IP rights and incentives for researchers; establishes the structure for the way an academic or research institution deals with the ownership and disposition of its IP. As such, it ensures certainty and well transparency to increase industry institute interaction. It recognizes that abstract atmosphere like inventions, copy right, project designs and other creative and innovative products generated during the scientific and intellectual procession of its faculty and its students provide a competitive edge to the institute.

2. Purpose of the IP Policy

The purpose of the IPR policy of institute is to:

- I. The essence of the IP Policy is to facilitate, promote & utilize the distributed use of various modalities of access to the staff members, researchers and students.
- II. The IP Policy anticipates setting the framework for the translation of the IP arising from the Institution's Research into products, services and processes. It encourages Staff Members, Students and to become Creators and to identify IP with potential commercial value.
- III. Establish IPR management policy i.e. clear rules and procedures for the institute and Commercialization of such IP generated at the Institution.
- IV. Provide a contributing environment directional to the development of Intellectual Property.
- V. Enabling the Institute to assure sponsored research funding at all levels of research.

3. Objective of the IP Policy

The objectives of the IPR policy of institute are as follows:

- I. To protect the intellectual property generated in the Institute from the scientific tasks and offers a scope for wealth generation.
 - II. To nurture all faculties, researchers and students to maintain document their IP, so that it could be shielded and applied to the beneficiary gain of the institute and the concerned creators.
 - III. To create an environment for capturing new knowledge or motive through innovation and research, harmonious with the educational vision and mission of the Institute.
 - IV. To promote awareness of Intellectual Property Right's as marketable assets.
 - V. To promote academic freedom and security measures the intellectual property interests of all those who are concerned in the invention of intellectual property at the Institute.

4. Policy Statement

The institute is bounded for facilitating, promoting, encouraging, protecting, administrating and commercializing the Intellectual property consistent with the recognition that among its primary objectives and functions is teaching, research and meeting the needs of the community and society. The Institution will accelerate an individual and encyclopaedic policy on IP, in order to increase the awareness of Faculty Members and Researchers about right to use, outline requirements for disclosure of IP and establish procedures to identify them avoid or properly manage such conflicts. The inventors of intellectual property under the terms of this policy shall be required to determine and to state that to the best of their knowledge the intellectual property does not infringe any existing copyright or other intellectual property or other legal rights of third parties.

5. Types of Intellectual Property

The intellectual properties have been broadly classified and illustrated as follows:

- a) Patents
 - b) Copyrights
 - c) Trade / Service marks
 - d) Industrial Designs
 - e) IC layout designs
 - f) New plant variety
 - g) Traditional knowledge and Geographical Indications
 - h) Software programmes

6. Ownership of Intellectual Property:

Ownership: The IP policy has to be accepted and signed by all MET Personnel. MET owns all the Intellectual Property (IP) that is produced by all MET personnel. MET reserves the right to apply for IP protection in India throughout the world/specific countries for suitable protection of the IP generated.

Dispute Resolution: In case of any conflict between MET and the inventors/creators regarding the implementation of the IP policy, the strain party may appeal to the Principal, IOE of MET. Endeavours shall be made to address the concerns of the strain party through the appointment of a committee of proficient members and the judgement of the Committee is final.

Jurisdiction: All agreements to be signed by MET's will have the jurisdiction of the court in Nashik and shall be governed by appropriate laws of India.

IPR Committee:

IPR committee consist of:

- 1) Institute IPR Coordinator: Prof. Dr. S. V. Gumaste
- 2) Co-Coordinator: Prof. Dr. D.P.Kadam
- 3) One Project coordinator from each Department.

The current role of IPR Committee

Includes the following, which may be revised from time to time.

- a) Conducting IP awareness programs for educating faculty/ students/ supporting staff/ project staff/ researchers at MET's Bhujbal Knowledge City, Nashik
 - b) The IPR Committee coordinator shall organize regular IPR meetings of department coordinators and train them for various IPR activities.
 - c) Maintaining records of the Institution's IP in an appropriate form and in sufficient detail.
 - d) Monitoring the deadlines for the payment obligations related to maintenance or annuity fees of protected IP.
-

- e) Maintain income/expense accounting records on each IP so that revenue sharing allocations can be calculated.
- f) To provide record of the filled IPs and to track the various IPs filed so as to ensure a speedy and hassle free IP process.
- g) To form expert groups with faculty members from different background to assess the proposals for filing IP.
- h) To provide service to faculty/ students/ supporting staff/ project staff/ researchers in all IPR application activities.
- i) The respective department coordinator should complete the procedure drafting and e-filing of a patent through Patent Scientific advisor's/Patent agent.
- j) Guidance for Scientific advisor's/ patent agent examination and other such certification exams/courses.
- k) Regularly review the IP cases for maintenance / discontinuation.

Role of Institute

- a) The inventor(s) shall conduct IP searches, study the present state of art while drafting of the IP application.
 - b) It has been decided that while filing the patent, an applicant should be an Institute and Inventors are faculties & students. Henceforth, the application will be filed in the name 'MET Institute of Engineering, Bhujbal Knowledge City, Adgaon, Nashik'.
For this, the institute shall bear Rs.6000/- (as per fees payable table: Number of entry 1 i.e. others, alone or with natural person(s) and/or start up and/or small entity)
 - c) The inventor shall bear all costs of drafting and filling authority registry fee for Patent (Form 1 fees: whatever is applicable).

Revenue Sharing

All rights in respect of the intellectual property created out of the investigations at the institute making use of the Institute's resources shall vest in and be the absolute property of the Institute.

The guideline for sharing the net earnings or the revenue arising out from the commercialization of Institute-owned intellectual property and royalty would be shared between the inventor(s) and the Institute (Applicant) in the appropriate ratio or scale will apply for institute IP as follows:
