

Report: 100-Day Intensified Campaign on TB Elimination on dated 15th Jan 2025

Conducted through National Service Scheme (NSS) NSS Code – D-72

The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare launched the 100-Day Intensified TB Elimination Campaign on 7th December 2024, focusing on active case finding in vulnerable populations, early diagnosis, prompt treatment initiation, and linkage to nutritional support.

As per the directives received from the Department of Minister of Health and Family welfare, All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), "A 100-Day Intensified Campaign on TB Elimination" was successfully conducted on Monday, January 15, 2025 at Chandori, Nashik through the National Service Scheme (NSS), NSS Code – D-72.

Goals and Objectives:

- To create mass awareness about Tuberculosis (TB) and its prevention.
- To promote early diagnosis and treatment among vulnerable groups.
- To involve students and staff in public health education.
- To connect suspected TB patients with health centers.

In alignment with this national mission, our institution undertook the following key activities:

A. Awareness Programs

- Conducted a TB awareness session at Chandori, Nashik on 15th January 2025.
- Chief Guest for the program was Dr. Vikas Vanjari (API, Chandori), who addressed the audience on TB awareness and prevention.

- NSS and Health Club members led awareness initiatives and distributed informative materials.


C. Health Screening and Referral


- TB screening was facilitated for members of the local community at Chandori.
- Suspected cases were referred to nearby public health centers for further diagnosis and care.


