PM-YUVA Mentorship Scheme 2.0 has been launched by the Ministry of Education, Government of India to train young and budding authors (below 30 years of age) for the year 2022-23 through the National Book Trust, India as the Implementing Agency.

The Theme of PM-YUVA 2.0 is Democracy (Institutions, Events, People, and Constitutional Values). The scheme will help to develop a stream of writers who can write on various facets of Democracy in India encompassing the past, present and future.

An online National Contest is being organized from 2nd October 2022 - 15<sup>th</sup> January 2023 to select the authors under the Scheme. There is a provision for payment of a Scholarship of Rs. 50,000 per month for a period of six months to be paid to each of the selected 75 authors. National Book Trust, India will be publishing the books produced by the young authors as part of the Mentorship Scheme.
