




Minutes of Academic Assessment and Quality Improvement Committee Meeting

1. At the beginning Dr. M. U. kharat briefed about the results for SE, TE, BE, Phase- I and Phase-II by highlighting the subjects having less results.
2. Dr. R. S. Tiwari focused that subjects having less results are having mathematical and logical background and suggested that more practice is needed on the problems covering complex logic / algorithms. For this, subject teacher shall conduct extra lectures covering these topics in separate time slot in the week. To monitor the progress, mock test on these topics may also be conducted.
3. Dr. S. S. Sane gave stress on need for making the core subjects more interesting by adapting pedagogical approach and creating background and facility for students to engage in self learning and making more use of NPTEL video lectures.
4. Dr. S. V. Gumaste insisted on the development of model answers for previous University examinations. Study of question papers and its pattern is an art and students will get an exposure of writing point wise answers while attempting questions during University examination.
5. Prof P M Yawalkar suggested that students should be given assignments/ question bank on each unit so that it will help the students in visualizing the possible questions from examination point of view.
6. The need for increase in the count of distinction and first class so as to get better job opportunities was raised by all the members.
7. The meeting ended with a thanking vote by Prof P. M. Yawalkar.
