**Participation and Response**

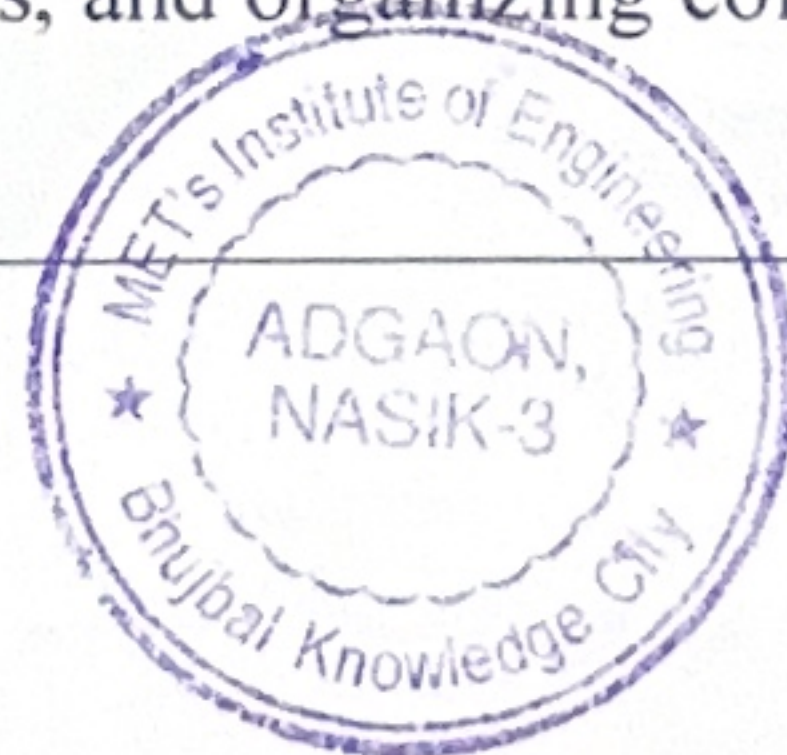
