GPS Map Camera

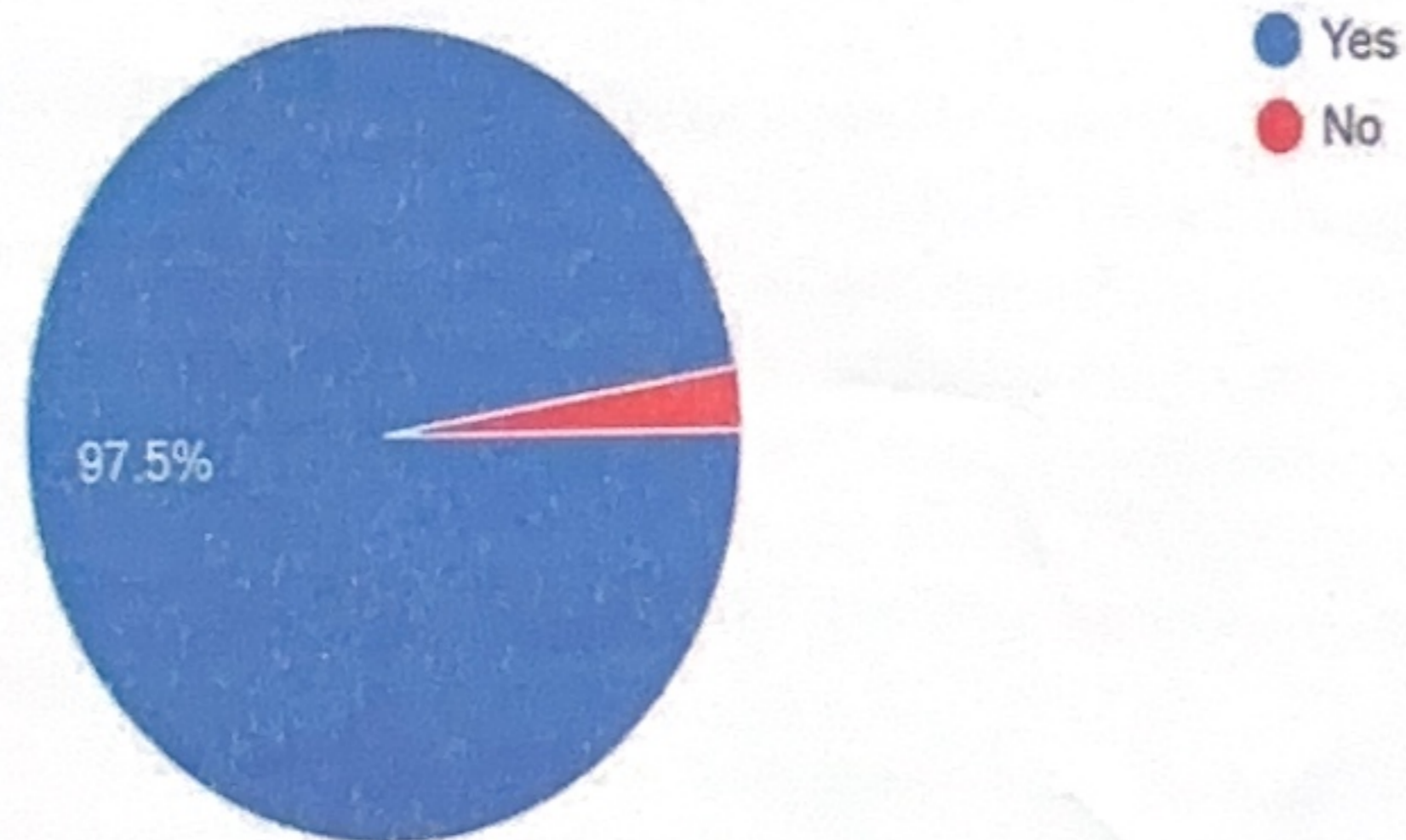
