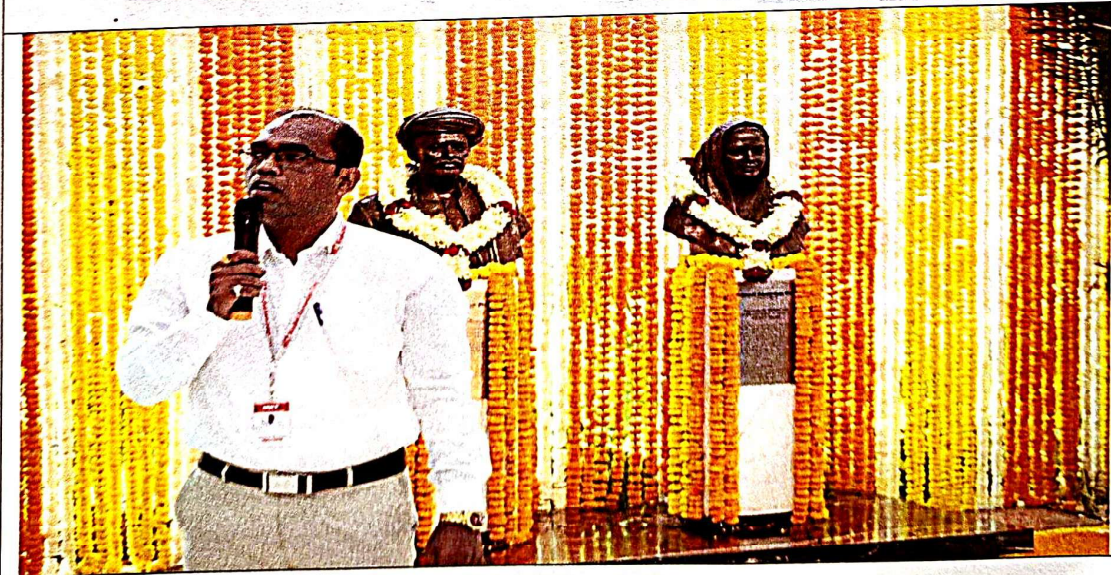
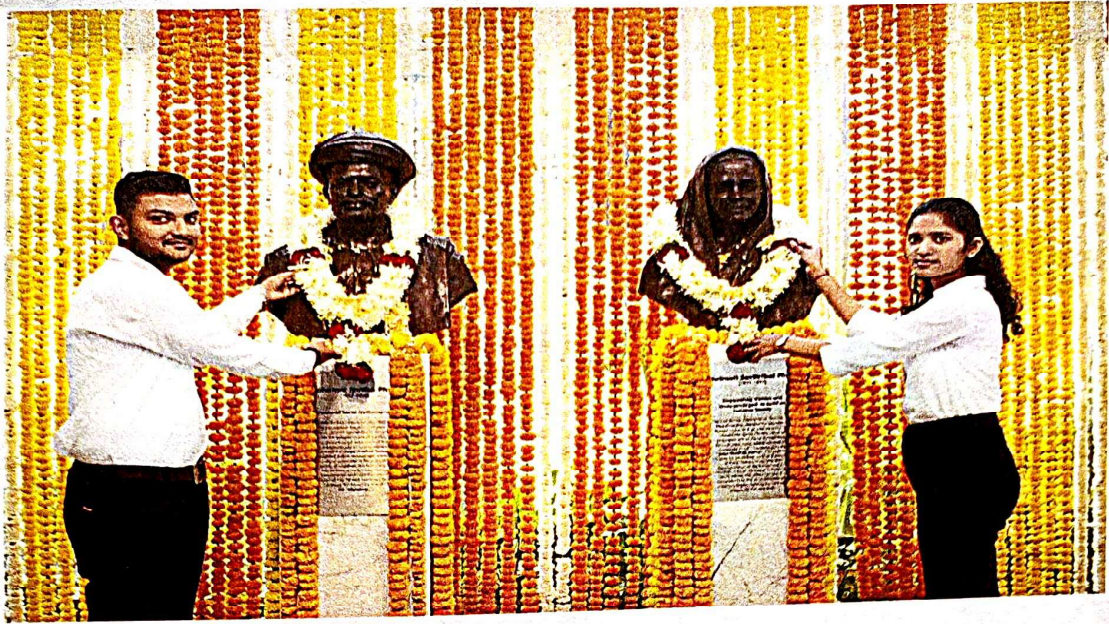
Outcomes of the Program
