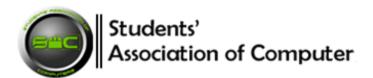
Grand Cultural Night:

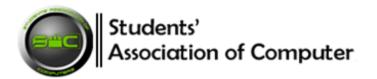

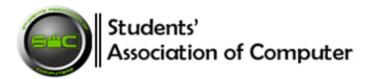
